- 2. Applicant must be planning to attend an accredited school or institute within 1 year of high school graduation.
- 3. Applicant must have had a significant influence/participation in the Wright County Fair within the past three years with a minimum of four years participation.
- 4. Family members of Wright County Fair Board members are eligible to apply.
- 5. Using the electronic application form, the applicant must submit the completed and signed application by March 31 (postmarked) to: Wright County Fair Scholarship Committee, PO Box 125, Eagle Grove, IA 50533.
- 6. The applicant must submit one letter of recommendation from a Wright County resident (not employed with the school district and not a member of the Wright County Fair Board) in an envelope sealed by the writer along with their application.
- 7. The scholarship committee may request to interview the scholarship applicant prior to making their award selection.
